(a) Thermal Cycler

06 bids were received. Bid received from M/S Sure Bio Diagnostic was rejected because the cycler they quoted has a short life span (supporting 100,000 cycles only) and therefore does not support our working demands as it was mentioned in our PO forms. Quotation received from M/S Diagnostics indicated that the gradient option can be enable but it is not included which is required for our work and indicated in the tender document (this specifies that it will be incorporated on request which then further add up into the total amount as an accessories). Among the valid bids, S.S.P.I. quoted the lowest price with all the specifications mentioned in our document. After careful evaluation, the Committee has recommended that the tender may be awarded to M/s S.S.P.I., as they meet our required specifications and are the lowest among all bidders.

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
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
