On securing more than 70% score, the committee jointly declared both the firms as technically qualified.

Note: No interband ratings allowed in application of the above rating scale. For example, only a rating of 90 or 80 can be given, not 85, 87, etc.

2 Financial Proposals:

The financial proposals received from the above two law firms were opened in the presence of committee. M/s RIAALAW offered PKR 900,000/- exclusive for the local taxes whereas M/s KMS Law offered $\stackrel{.}{\bowtie}$ 850,000/- exclusive the local taxes , which shall be identified during negotiations and shall be added to the above amount.

The firms were scored on 80:20 ratios for technical and financial bids.

The committee considered the offer of M/s RIAALAW and awarded 87.6% score and 78.8% score to M/s KMS Law Associates on 80-20 basis criteria.

3 Recommendations:

In view of the technical and financial evaluation as per position given above, the committee on securing 87.6% technical and financial score declared M/s RIAALAW qualified, standing at No.1 whereas M/s KMS Law Associates securing 78.8% score at No.2, It is pertisent to mention that M/s RIAALAW clarified that no out of pocket money will be claimed but only applicable taxes would be paid by the department,
