1.	Are the provisional sum amounts included in the total contract price? Should the provisional sum also be considered in the calculated amount for bid bond/ bid security?	Yes, all provisional sum amounts in the BoQ are part of the total contract price and the bid security should be calculated accordingly.

2.	Will income tax be deducted?	As per rules, income tax will be deducted.
3.	Is the project also exempt from provincial taxes by SRB?	Yes, letter attached.
4.	The contractors requested that repair of generating sets (Bill No. 3 of BoQ) be deleted from the scope of this contract and may be added as additional work after award to successful bidder's contract.	There is no change in the scope of work of this contract.
5.	Is the price of motor control unit (MCC/MCU) to be incorporated in item no. 5/1i) and 5/1ii)?	Price of LT motor control Centre is asked in item 5/1vii).
6.	Who will provide security to construction contractor at site?	Security at site including for plant, machinery, equipment, labor and employees will be the responsibility of successful bidder. However, seven different construction contractors have already been working in Jacobabad since 2014 in coordination with the local administration.
7.	Who will provide office and labor accommodation for contractor?	Contractor is responsible for establishing his office at site and other facilities for his staff and labor. However, establishment of camp yard/ site office must comply with the requirements of <i>Volume-IV Environmental Documentation Forms</i> .
8.	Safety equipment/ HSE compliance.	EDF document is part of the bidding documents which lists all possible environmental impacts and their mitigation measures. The contractor is supposed to comply with all the requirements listed in the document during construction without any additional charges. The contractor is also required to take all the necessary Health and Safety precautions for its labors including correct use of Personal Protection Equipment (PPE), use of fencing, barriers etc.
9.	Who will provide security to pumps and generators upon procurement at site?	Until taking over of completed works by the Employer, security of all procured equipment/ machines will be contractor's responsibility.
10.	Who will be responsible for defects detected in equipment during defect liability period?	The Contractor will be responsible for defects in equipment during defect liability period.


