2. The tenders in sealed cover superscripted with the name of work should be dropped in the tender box kept in the office of Department of Antiquities @ Field Office Sehwan at Kafir Qilla Sehwan, by 2:00 P.M on 22-02-2013 and opened by the Tender Opening Committee on the same day at 3:00 p.m. in the presence of those representatives who wish to be present.
