Invitation for bids & Collection of Bid Documents

- The Program Management and Implementation Unit, Sindh Basic Education Program (SBEP) (the "Procuring Agency") has funds from the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) towards the cost of construction of new schools or up gradation of existing schools in seven districts of northern Sindh and five towns of Karachi under SBEP. It is intended that part of the proceeds of the grant will be applied to eligible payments under the contract for the construction of schools in two talukas of Khairpur district, Package-02: Construction of nine Schools. Bidding is open to all pregualified bidders only.
- 2. Bidders may obtain information by acquiring the Bidding Documents from the office of the procuring agency at *House No 29-D*, *Block 2*, *Clifton*, *Karachi*, *Pakistan*
- 3. Procuring Agency invites sealed bids from interested firms or persons licensed by the Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) in the category C-1 or above for the works and in disciplines CE-10 and registered with relevant tax authorities. A foreign bidder is entitled to bid only in a joint venture with a Pakistani firm in accordance with the relevant provisions of PEC bye-laws.
- 4. A complete set of bidding documents may be obtained from PMIU office at 29-D, Block 2, Clifton, Karachi without any cost from 9th to 13th September, 2013 during working hours, upon submitting written request addressed to the Program Director, PMIU-SBEP, on the letter head of the prequalified firm.
- 5. All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of Rs. 8.0 million (Rupees eight

million) or an equivalent amount in a freely convertible currency in the name of Program Director, and must be delivered to PMIU office, 29-D, Block 2, Clifton, Karachi, Pakistan at or before 1400 hours, on 30th September, 2013. Bids will be opened at 1430 hours on the same day, in the presence of bidder's representatives who choose to attend at the same address.

- 6. A pre-bid meeting shall be held on 18th September, 2013 at 1100 hrs in the office of PMIU. The bidders may send their queries according to the ITB 8.1 of Tender Conditions.
- 7. Procuring agency reserves right to annul the bidding process and/ or reject all bids or proposals, as per SPP Rules 2010.
