EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR THIRD PARTY MONITORING

Contract for delivery of Engineering Consultancy Services to carry out the Third Party Monitoring (TPM) of selected on-going development schemes of Road Sector in selected Districts of Sindh for FY 2013-14".

- The Government of Sindh with the broad objective of connecting economic and social growth is making huge investments in various Public Sector Development schemes both through Annual Development Plan (ADP) and the Federal Public Sector Development Programs. For that purpose, during the current Financial Year 2013-14, Government of Sindh has allocated an amount of Rs.185 Billions for Annual Development Plan.
- Given the scale of on-going investments, it is highly desirable to undertake Third Party Monitoring of the implementation of these investments with a view to facilitate a third party information and confirmation of various aspects of these investments. In this perspective, Government of Sindh through a development scheme namely "Strengthening of Monitoring & Evaluation Cell (MEC) in Planning & Development Department including outsourcing for Third Party Monitoring" executed by Monitoring & Evaluation Cell (MEC) P&D Department, plans to facilitate an institutional monitoring & evaluation of a range of public sector interventions.
- The funding for subject activity is from on-going scheme of "Strengthening of Monitoring & Evaluation Cell P&D including out sourcing for Third Party Monitoring (ADP No. 2194), P&D Department, Government Sindh.
- The objective of this assignment is to facilitate institutional accountability & transparency of the public sector expenditures through a technical and third party monitoring/review and evaluation of the implementation of public sector interventions.
- The scope and extent of the Third Party Monitoring (TPM) is to monitor & evaluate the execution & implementation of selected on-going development schemes of roads in Sindh and report up-to-date position.
- In this regard, MEC, P&D Department, Government of Sindh invites the Expression of Interest (EOI) for prequalification from the consultant firms registered with PEC in relevant category. The consulting firms should have at least 10 years demonstrable experience in monitoring & evaluation of Public Sector development projects related to Roads / Highways / Bridges through intervening implementation of documentation & laboratory tests.
- Interested consulting firms are invited to register their interest for participation by sending the following 7. information in quadruplicate:
 - Name, address, telephone, fax numbers and e-mail address of consultants
 - ii. Ownership and Organizational Structure of the consultants
 - iii. Financial Statement summary for the past three years
 - iv. List of major (similar) assignments under-taken so far.
 - v. Names and Short CVs of Principal Staff
 - vi. Valid registration certificate from income tax authority (NTN).
 - vii. Valid Pakistan Engineering Council registration certificate in relevant category.

viii. Affidavit that firm has never been blacklisted or debarred by any Government/Semi-Government organization.

- EOI proposal shall be prepared in English language.
- ii. Any lapse to provide essential information may result in disqualification of the applicant.
- iii. MEC, P&D Department, Government of Sindh reserves the right to waive minor deviations, if these don't materially affect the capability of an applicant to perform the contract.
- iv. All clarifications must be sought five calendar days prior to date of opening through e-mail request.
- v. At any time prior to deadline, the MEC, P&D Department, Government of Sindh may issue amendment / addenda.
- vi. MEC, P&D Department, Government of Sindh shall disqualify the applicant, if at any stage, it finds that the information submitted for prequalification was either significantly inaccurate or dubious/tempered.
- vii. Consultants shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of their proposals. The MEC, P&D, Government of Sindh reserves the right to annul the procurement process at any time without thereby incurring any liability to the Applicant Firms as per SPPRA Rules 2010.
- The deadline for receipt of EOI proposals is dated: 09th December, 2013, 12:00 Hours (Noon). EOI /Applications received after this date shall not be entertained.
