NOTICE INVITING TENDER

SOLAR POWER GENERATION SYSTEM FOR WATER FILTRATION PLANTS INSTALLED IN ALL DISTRICT OF SINDH UNDER PHASE – I (300 PLANTS) AND PHASE – II (750 PLANTS) OF THE PROJECT “ DRINKING WATER HUBS”, NANO FILTRATION / ULTRA FILTRATION / REVERSE OSMOSIS WATER FILTRATION PLANTS OF CAPACITY 15000 GALLONS (US) PER DAY.

Scope of Work:

Design, Supply, install, commissioned, operate and maintain solar power system for water filtration plants installed under phase – I (300 Plants) and phase – II (750 Plants) for the project “ Drinking Water Hubs” – Nano Filtration / Ultra Filtration / Reverse Osmosis Water Filtration Plants of Capacity 15000 Gallons (US) Per Day in Different Districts of Province of Sindh”. The electric power supply for water filtration plants will be provided by solar PV cells either mono or Polycrystalline type with 20-25 years maintenance free life. The completion period is twelve (12) months for the job.

As specified in SPPRA rules 46(2) **Bid shall comprise a single package containing two separate envelopes marked as “Financial Proposal” and “Technical Proposal”** in bold and legible letters to avoid confusion. The Technical Proposal found technically qualified under evaluation / marking criteria given in bidding documents would only be considered for opening of Financial Proposal.

The bidding is open to all firms (that is local manufacturer, authorized representatives of international manufacturer and engineering firms who are meeting the following criteria.

1. Valid Registration with Pakistan Engineering Council in Category C-3 or above necessarily having specialization in CE-09, EC-10 and EE-03 in relevant categories and amount.
2. Incorporation certificate from SECP and chamber of commerce.
3. Registration with Tax authorities.
4. Last three year audited financial statement.
5. Latest certificate from the bank confirming that the company has strong financial strength to undertake and complete the subject project within stipulated time frame.
6. Proven track record to install and operate similar type of project in Pakistan.
7. Technical strength in shape of engineering team working on payroll and list of engineers working with the bidder and also registered in PEC on bidder profile.
8. Certificate confirming that the bidder never in litigation with any of its client or government department.
9. Distribution Agreement (s) / JV Agreement (s) and technical association with the international manufacturer / OEM.
10. Address of regional offices (if any in Sindh Province)
11. Certified design from technology provider (s) confirming that the specified technology is designed for the subject project.
12. Provide 20-25 years comprehensive warranty for maintenance free operation of the subject project (covering free replacement of equipment / membranes).

The detailed Terms of Reference (TOR) / Bidding Documents containing job description, Evaluation Criteria, terms & conditions, information and guidelines for preparation of Bid can be obtained from the office of Project Director (PMU), Drinking Water Hub, Special Initiative Department, **F-158/ A-II Block -5, Clifton Near SZABIST, Karachi** upon payment of Rs. 10,000/= (non refundable) in shape of payorder / demand draft in the name of Project Director PMU, Drinking Water Hub.

All bids (Technical) must be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of Rs. 25.00 M(Rupees Twenty Five Million Only) in shape of Pay order or a bank guarantee issued by a Scheduled Bank in Pakistan or from a foreign bank duly counter guaranteed by a Scheduled Bank in Pakistan in favour of Project Director Project Management Unit , Special Initiative Department and must be delivered to the Office of Project Director (PMU), Drinking Water Hub, Karachi , Pakistan at or before 3:00 pm , on 06 -02-2014.

The Technical Proposals of bids will be **opened at 4:00 P.M on the same day**, in the presence of bidders representatives who choose to attend, at the same address. The Financial Proposals of only the technically qualified bidders shall be opened on date & time to be notified later. The bids received beyond the schedule date and time will not be entertained. The Project Director will not be responsible for any delay in postage.
