**EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI)**

Sports and Youth Affairs Department Government of Sindh has launched ADP project "**Youth Health Awareness Programme-YHAP**" to create awareness among the youth throughout the province of Sindh to sensitize them about their health issues by adopting participatory approach for improving the quality of life by arriving at sustainable national development. The main objectives of the project are to motivate youth to adopt health seeking behaviour, reduce morbidity and establish strong linkages between the youth and formal health care system.

Project Director **Youth Health Awareness Programme – YHAP** invites Expression of Interest (EOI) from medical universities, health training providers and organizations to impart short term "Advanced Youth Health Training Workshop" for a period of two weeks to 55 young individuals having no medial background from all districts of Sindh.

The objectives of the training workshop:-

- a) Transform the trainees into Young Health Leaders to serve in their respective areas to impart the same trainings and awareness health sessions for the benefits of other youth of their areas.
- b) To inform youth about general health and hygiene issues and contagious and non-contagious diseases.
- c) Capacity building of youth through modern and latest information
- d) Increase youth moral values
- e) Provide platform to remove youth health related myths and fears
- f) Provide a platform to express youth health problems
- g) Designate them as youth health ambassador of Government
- h) Promote peer education
- i) Mobilize youth for community mobilization and community development
- j) Strengthen the youth and community through participatory approach
- k) Develop skills for knowledge management
- l) Develop youth leadership skills

The training contents and modules shall be based on an updated international medical knowledge and informative system. The following information supported with the documents required for the pre-qualification:

- Relevant training experience and past performance.
- Registration with Recognized Certificate/Diploma awarding Board / University– [National or International – An international certificate SHALL be preferred].
- Capabilities of training in respect of infrastructure faculty, equipment / machines and other resources.
- Capabilities of facilitation for providing post training guidance and assistance.
