Expression of Interest - Translation and Composing of Curricula in Urdu & Sindhi

iLEAD-Inspiring Leadership, Empowerment and Development in Youth is a collaborative project of the Sports & Youth Affairs Department, Government of Sindh and Habib University Foundation (H.U.F.).It is an innovative youth development program that aims at facilitating youth to aspire for a healthy and active life style and build leadership skills. iLEAD uses Community Services, Sports, Health & Fitness activities as key tools to Educate, Inspire and Engage youth. The project is being implemented in five districts of Sindh including Karachi, Hyderabad, Sukkur, Mirpurkhas and Larkana.

Nurturing Healthy Minds and Bodies (NHMB) Curriculum is a sports for positive youth development curriculum to acquaint youth (13 to 18 years) with the skills for leading a healthy and a productive life focusing on developing self, health and fitness and values and skills for sports and games. The curriculum focuses on active learning pedagogy i.e. presentation, group work, guest speaker session, debates, discussions and sports activities etc.

EnergActive is another curriculum focusing on development of Basic Sports Skills amongst students aged I3 to 12 years. The core purpose of the program is to make children energetic and active to adopt an active life style for a healthy living. The program aims at introducing fun activities focusing of fundamental motor skills, sports skills and general fitness to children and adolescents to help them to be physically fit and active.
