

JINNAH SINDH MEDICAL UNIVERSITY (JSMU) invites single stage two envelopes tender under SPPRA Rules, 2010 for providing the services of Group Health Insurance from well reputed insurance companies who qualify eligibility criteria for the Calendar year 2015 for the following lives:

Task to be performed by the Insurer

To provide Medical Benefits across Pakistan in line with the Scope of Work mentioned in the technical proposal

To ensure that their concerned staff/representative shall behave properly and friendly with employees /staff/dependents of JSMU, Karachi

To co-ordinate say to say matters/affairs with the any authorized officer of JSMU, Karachi regularly

Financial proposals of only those bidders will be opened who score more than 80% marks in the technical evaluation criteria. Then the technically qualified bidders will be given scores as per the financial evaluation criteria. Maximum 3 bidders with highest score will be called for presentation/meeting/negotiation. Bidders who do not qualify cannot challenge the findings of evaluation or ask for reasons thereof.

The contract period will be of one year but can be further renewed for 1 year based on excellent customer services and feedback of employees through the authorized officer.






