



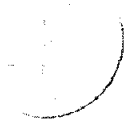

However, joint Venture experience and resources shall be considered. Consortium of Association of Firms will be considered for similar treatment as in case of joint Venture.

### 3.2.2 General Experience

The Applicant shall meet the following minimum criteria:

- a) Average annual turnover which is also termed as Income from contracting. Revenue or Sales and is defined as billing for works in progress and completed annually over the last five years of Rs.50 Million
- b) Successful experience as prime Contractor in the execution of at last one project of a nature and complexity comparable to the proposed contract (s) within the last last three days years. This experience should include.

### 3.2.5 Financial Position

3.2.5.1 The contractor should demonstrate that he has access to, or has available liquid assets, un-encumbered real assets, lines, of credit and other financial means sufficient to meet the construction cash flow for other period of four month, estimated as Pak. Rs.15.00 Million or equivalent. Net of the contractor's commitments for other ongoing contracts shall also be considered.

3.2.5.2 The audited balance sheets for the past three years should demonstrate the soundness of the contractor's Financial Position, showing long term profitability. Where necessary, the Employer will make enquiries with the contractor's bankers.

### 3.2.6 Litigation History

The contractor should provide accurate information on any litigation or arbitration resulting from contracts complete or under execution over the last three years. A consistent history of award against the contractor or any Partner of a joint venture may result in rejection of the application.

### Joint Venture (JV)

3.3.1 Joint Venture must comply with the following requirements:-

a) Following are minimum qualification requirements:-

- i. The lead partner shall meet not less than 50 percent of all qualifying criteria given in Paras 3.2 and 3.5 heretofore.
- ii. Each of the partners shall meet not less than 25 percent of all the qualifying criteria given in Paras 3.2 and 3.5 heretofore.
- iii. The joint venture must collectively satisfy the criteria of Para of all 3.2, 3.5 and 3.6, for which purpose the relevant figures for each of the partners shall be added together to arrive at JV's total capacity. Individual members must satisfy each of the requirement of Paras 3.5 and 3.6 heretofore.
- iv. The International constructors have to establish joint venture with local constructs on submission of the following relevant documents, subject to the condition that share of the Pakistani constructions of Pakistani operators shall not less than 30 Percent.

Letter of Intent by IFC to the lead Pakistani constructor or Pakistani operator and endorsement certificate of the foreign constructor or foreign operator.

Joint venture or association agreement of the parties specifying share of each party and name of the lead Pakistani constructor or Pakistani operator; and

Brief description and scope of work for which the association of joint venture intends to participate in bidding.

b) Any change in a prequalified JV after prequalification, shall be subject to the written approval of the Employer prior to the deadline for submission of bids. Such approval may be denied if:

- i. Partner (s) withdraw from a JV and remaining partners do not meet the qualifying requirements;
- ii. The new partners to a JV are not qualified individually or as another JV; or
- iii. In the opinion of the Employer, a substantial reduction in competition would result.

c) Bid shall be signed by all members in the JV so as to legally bind all partners, jointly and severally, and any bid shall be submitted with a copy of the JV agreement providing the joint and several liabilities with respect to the contract.

3.3.2 The prequalification of a JV does not necessarily pre-qualify any of its partners individually or as a partner in any other JV or association. In case of dissolution of a JV, each one of the constituent firms may pre-qualify if they meet all the prequalification requirements and any partner of JV has requested/ shall requested for the same and then this prequalification shall be subject to the written approval of the Employer.

#### 3.4 Conflict of Interest

3.4.1 The contractor (including all members of a JV) must not be associated, nor have been associated in the past, with the consultant or any the entity that has prepared the design, specification, and other prequalification and bidding documents for the project, or was proposed as Engineer for the contract, over the last five years. Any such association may result in disqualification of the contractor.

#### 3.5 Updating Prequalification Information

3.5.1 Bidders shall be required to update the financial, personnel and equipment information used for prequalification at the time of submitting their bids, to confirm their continued compliance with the qualification criteria and verification if the contractor's qualification there holds are not longer met at the time of bidding.

#### 3.6 Other Factors

3.6.1 Only firm and JVs that have been pre-qualified under this procedure shall be invited to bid. A qualified firm or a member of a qualified JV may participate only in one bid for the contract. If a firm submits more than one bid, singly or as a JV, all bids including that bidder will be rejected. This rule will not apply in respect of bids, which include specialist sub-contractors who are used by more than one bidder.

3.6.2 The Employer's representatives reserves the right to:

- a) Amend the scope and value of any contract(s) to be bid, in which event the bidder(s) will only bid among those pre-qualified bidders who meet the requirements of the contract(s) as amended. However the Employer has to review the disqualified bids who originally do not meet the specified criteria for prequalification.
- b) Reject or accept any application; and
- c) Cancel the prequalification process and reject all applications.

The Employer shall neither be liable for any such actions nor be under any obligation to inform the contractor of the grounds for rejection; however, may be debriefed if solicited.

3.6.3 Contractors will be informed in writing by fax or mail within 48 days of the submission of applications (Para 8 of Chapter 2.0, invitation for prepublication) the result of their applications and may be debriefed if solicited.

#### 3.7 Fraud and Corruption

It is policy of the GOS to require its staff and its contractor to observe the highest standard of ethics during the selection and execution of such contracts pursuant of this Policy, GOS:

- a. Defines, for the purposes of this provision, the terms set forth below:

- (i) "Corrupt practice" means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting, directly or indirectly, of any thing of value to influence the action of a public official in the
  - (ii) "Fraudulent practice" means a misrepresentation or omission of facts in order to influence a selection process or the execution of a contract;
  - (iii) "Collusive practice" means harming or threatening to harm, directly or indirectly, persons or their property to influence their participation in an procurement process, or affect the execution of a contract.
- (b) Will reject a proposal for award if it determines that the constructor recommended for award has directly or through an agent, engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive or coercive practices in competing for the contract in question.
- (c) Will sanction a construction including declaring the constructor ineligible, either indefinitely or for stated period of time, to be awarded a COS contract if it at any time determines that the contract has, directly or through an agent, engaged in corrupt fraudulent, collusive or coercive practices.

#### 4.6 EVALUATION CRITERIA

Applicants meeting the minimum requirements mentioned in Para 3.2 besides other facts shall be considered for prequalification. No compromise shall be made on Key Personnel, academic qualification and experience. History of excessive contract arbitrations and litigation resulting in decision against them will be considered sufficient ground for disqualification.
