- Government of Sindh allocated funds for this Project, the work will be executed through Energy Department/Sindh Coal Authority. Broad Scope, Total Estimated Cost and other details are as under: -
 - (i) **Scope:** To develop Thar Coalfield by providing Infrastructure especially road network which is required to be of such standard to sustain expected heavy axle loads. Considering the requirement of heavy *vehicles* the Government of Sindh, Energy Department/Sindh Coal Authority has therefore decided for construction of new link roads, bypasses and improvement/widening/strengthening of existing road network which lead to Thar Coalfields.
 - (ii) **Estimated Cost:** Pak Rs.10,000.00 million
 - (iii) **Project Completion Period:** 24 months.
 - (iv) **Bidding Process:** National Competitive Bidding (NCB)

The Government of Sindh, Energy Development Department is taking steps to provide enabling infrastructure to generate power/energy from the Coal, which is a natural gift available in mass quantity in the desert area of the Tharparkar District in the Province of Sindh. For exploring the coal by open cast mining and power generation, heavy machinery and equipment is to be transported from Sea port Karachi to Thar Coal Field Area. As per requirements of the potential investors for providing safe access to transport their heavy equipment and machinery to the Coal Field Area, the existing road network needs to be improved to cater for heavy loading requirements. The Government of Sindh, Energy Development Department/Sindh Coal Authority has therefore decided to Construct new road links, Bypasses and Improve/widened/Rehabilitate existing roads in districts Thatta, Sujawal, Badin and Tharparkar.

Project Completion Period: 24 months
