## Section IV. Scope of Contracts: (Description of works)

The Special Initiative Department, Government of Sindh had undertaken a task to take-up the various infrastructure units preferably rural roads in less privileged areas of Sindh Province on purely need basis.

## Scheme 1: Construction of Var to Mitho sheikh Road (Phase - II), 8 Kms.

The Scope of Construction/ Rehabilitation of Var to Mitho Sheikh Road includes 5.5 m wide asphaltic surfaced two lane carriageway in addition to 2 m wide dressed shoulders on both side and RCC Box culverts.

# Scheme 2: Construction of Thatta Bypass on Sujawal Road to N-5 (Thatta Hyderabad Section), 8 Kms.

The Scope of Works involves construction of bypass road of standard parameters of 24 feet wide asphaltic surfaced two lane carriageway with surface treated shoulders on either sides over an earthen embankment including construction of cross road structures having 8km road length off taking from Thatta – Sujawal road near Biak Hotel and terminating behind village Chhato Chander at Hyderabad – Thatta Road.

## Scheme 3: Widening and Improvement of Thatta to Jungshahi Road, 22 Kms

The Scope of Improvement and Rehabilitation of existing about 10 ft wide deteriorated Thatta to Jungshahi road includes 1.5m widening of road on either side to upgrade it for a 5.5m wide asphaltic surface two lane carriageway in addition to rehabilitation and reconstruction of cross road structures i.e mostly replacement of about 30 years critically old stone masonry culverts with RCC box culverts. It also includes construction of 122 m long new bridge on stream crossing.
