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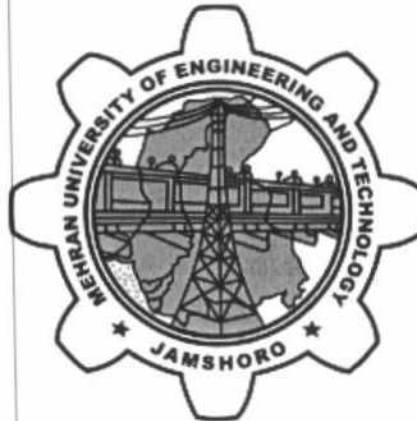

1. INTRODUCTION:

U.S. Pakistan Center for Advanced Studies in Water (USPCAS-W) is located at the Mehran University of Engineering and Technology (MUET) Jamshoro.
