**1.0 GENERAL CONDITIONS & INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1.1** In this tender, method of procurement shall be "SINGLE STAGE ONE ENVELOPE" procedure as per SPPRA rules 2010, Amended 2017.
- 1.2** The tender shall be submitted with all documents in sealed envelopes. The envelope must contain tender inquiry No. on the top, the name of the Bidder should be affixed on the face of the envelope on the left side. The envelope should be sealed and addressed to Commissioner SESSI Karachi and inserted in Tender box on the scheduled date and time.
- 1.3 Tender Proposal should have the following documents:**
- Original Tender receipt
  - Valid Manufacturing License, Valid Drug Sales License whichever is applicable.
  - NTN Certificate.
  - Sales Tax Registration Certificate.
  - Authority letter from manufacture/importer, incase of distributor (non manufacturer/ non importer).
  - Original Pay Order/Bank Draft of Earnest money/ Bid Security.
  - Original Bid offer.
  - Last three years tax returns of F.B.R. showing bidder's Annual Turnover more or equal than Rs.100 (Hundred) Million for three years.

1. Sealed tenders are invited from manufacturers/ importers/authorized distributors of medicines, for supply of medicines to the Institution on contract rate basis during the financial year 2017-18 as per "Single Stage One Envelope" procedure, Clause 46(1) of SPPRA Rules 2010, Amended 2017.
2. Tenders along with Terms & Conditions (in duplicate) may be purchased from the office of Cashier of the Institution on submission of pay order of **Rs.2,000/- (non-refundable)** from the date of publishing Notice in newspapers to **29-09-2017** during **9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.** Receipt of this amount along with a copy of Terms & Conditions duly signed and stamped by the tenderer, will be attached with the quotations/tenders as conclusive evidence of acceptance of the Terms & Conditions.
3. The Terms & Conditions form is part and parcel of, and supplementary to, this tender notice.
4. Tenders shall be accompanied by Bid Security @ 1% of the value of tender quoted by them in form of Pay Order / Demand Draft in favor of "Sindh Employee's Social Security Institution" which shall remain valid for 28 days beyond the Bid validity period.
5. Tenders in sealed envelopes should be addressed to Commissioner SESSI, Social Security House, St-17, Block-6, Rashid Minhas Road, Gulshan-e-Iqbal, Karachi-75300 (SESSI Head Office) and should be dropped in Tender Box at Head Office on **04-10-2017 from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 Noon** This will be opened on the same date at **12:30 p.m.** in the presence of those tenderers who may wish to be present.
6. The Procuring Agency may reject all or any bids subject to the relevant provisions of SPPRA Rules 2010, Amended 2017.

- 1.4 Only Manufacturer / Importer or their authorized distributor can participate in the Tender. The Distributor should submit authorization letter in Original addressed to Commissioner SESSI Karachi with reference to this Tender.
- 1.5 The tender must be free from erasing, cutting and over writing. In case of erasing, cutting and over writing, authorized person should initial it, duly stamped.
- 1.6 Rates of each item should be written in **figures as well as in words**. Arithmetical errors will be rectified on this basis. If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and the quantity, the unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected. In case of discrepancy the price in words will be authenticated and final.
- 1.7 No Tender will be entertained without Bid Security. Conditional tender will not be accepted.
- 1.8 Tenders shall be accompanied by Bid Security @ 1 % of the value of tender quoted by them in form of Pay Order / Demand Draft in favor of "Sindh Employees' Social Security Institution" which shall remain valid for 28 days beyond the Bid validity period.
- 1.9 The Bid Security shall be released to the unsuccessful bidders once the contract has been signed with the successful bidders or the validity period has expired.
- 1.10 The Bid Security shall be released to successful bidders after submission of performance security.
- 1.11 All Bidders will provide **THREE SAMPLES** (Commercial Pack) of quoted product free of cost in the office of Director Procurement on the very next day of the tender opening.
- 1.12 Following words shall be printed and stamped with indelible ink prominently in English "SESSI" "NOT FOR SALE" Outside and inside the Packing on all goods.
- 1.13 The tendered rate should be inclusive of all applicable taxes to Federal & Provincial Govt. or local bodies and will be deducted from the bill of the contractors / suppliers.
- 1.14 One "SAMPLE TENDER PROFORMA" is supplied with the lists of items to be purchased. The items have to be quoted on the Performa; duly filled stamped & signed by the authorized bidder. Only those items shall, be typed on the Performa / separate Letter head (as per serial of Performa) for which the rates are to be quoted. Any alteration/ correction must be initialed and each page is to be signed and stamped at the bottom.
- 1.15 Schedule is prepared with the generic name; however the bidder should also mention the brand name against the generic name.
- 1.16 The dosage form, strength and pack size offered for bidding in the tender shall be those which are registered / approved by the Ministry of Health. The dosage form, strength and pack size quoted by the bidder shall confirm to the ones mentioned in the tender form.
- 1.17 All I.V. Infusions should be quoted with I.V. sets **free of cost**, failing of which item shall not be accepted.
- 1.18 Registration number, make or origin of the country of the drug must be mentioned for each item, for which quotation is given, otherwise it will not be considered.
- 1.19 It is mandatory that drugs quoted are registered with the Federal Ministry of Health.
- 1.20 The supplies should be in commercial pack as per drug act 1976 and delivered at the designated place by the authorized representative of the firm at the risk and cost of the

supplier. Any breakage or shortage of stock will be recovered from the supplier.

- 1.21 The supplier shall submit a Completion Certificate/ Performance Certificate to the Procuring Agency within the 30 days of closing of contract as per Clause 57(1) of SPPRA Rule 2010, Amended 2017 in order to release performance security.
- 1.22 Payment shall be made to the supplier within **Thirty (30) Days** after supply of complete goods.
2. **SPECIAL CONDITIONS:**
  - 2.1 The quoted rates once offered by the firms will not be changed during the contract period.
  - 2.2 The bidders shall quote their price both in figure and in words on Free delivery basis to SESSI Hospitals and Circles.
  - 2.3 Distributor once nominated by the manufacturer / importer will be for the whole contract period and manufacturer / importer cannot change its distributor during the contract period in any case. In exceptional cases the tendering authority may approve changes.
  - 2.4 No manufacturer / importer shall authorize their distributor / agent / any firm or person to quote the same item, which the manufacturer is quoting itself in any tender. Failing those offers of both the manufacturer as well as other bidder shall be ignored.
  - 2.5 The manufacturer/importer supply sub-standard, misbranded or contaminated medicine(s) item(s) etc., those will be destroyed and payment will not be made to the supplier. The supplier will be responsible to provide the fresh stock of standard quality within 30 days against the rejected batch. Otherwise amount equivalent to the supplied quantity of defective goods will be deducted from their bill and supplier may be black listed by the competent authority accordance with the offence and hence their performance security may be forfeited.
  - 2.6 If goods are declared sub-standard the Manufacturer and their Distributor are equally responsible and are bound to supply additional quantity of whole batch free of cost.
  - 2.7 The institution will send samples for laboratory test randomly from time to time during contract period and bidder shall pay the testing fees directly to the Drug Testing Lab. for the batches to be supplied and should supply extra quantity of drug / drugs used for testing purpose.
  - 2.8 The Technical evaluation depends upon the documents provided by the bidder mentioned in Terms and Conditions of the tender.
  - 2.9 The supplier must provide all the medicines within 30 days from the date of issue of purchase order.
  - 2.10 Late Delivery (LD) charges of 2% will be deducted for every 15 days after 30 days of issuing of purchase order for further 30 days.
  - 2.11 After 60 days of non-compliance of purchase order, the institution has right to purchase those medicines from open market and Risk and Cost shall be deducted from the bill of the supplier. Moreover 10% amount of non-executed item will also be deducted from performance security.
  - 2.12 If any of the firm/supplier will not supply the medicines after getting award of contract, the whole performance security shall be forfeited and the same may be black listed.
  - 2.13 Alternate offer shall not be accepted. If any item shall be quoted with alternate offer, the whole item shall be ignored.

3. **PURCHASER'S RIGHT TO VARY QUANTITIES**

The authority reserves right to increase / decrease or delete the quantities of medicines / drugs / etc. at the time of award of contract and also reserves the right to enhance the quantity of goods originally specified in the schedule of requirement without any change in unit price or other terms and conditions of goods at any time during contract period.

4. **PURCHASER'S RIGHT TO ACCEPT ANY BID AND REJECT ANY OR ALL BIDS:**

The Competent authority reserves the right to purchase full or part of the store or ignore / scrap / cancel the tender as per relevant rules of SPPRA-2010.

5. **PERFORMANCE SECURITY:**

The successful bidders will have to deposit the requisite security in the shape of a Pay Order / Demand Draft at 2% value of the order amount. The same will be released after successful completion of stores. After the acceptance of the Tender by the Vendor, a purchase order may be issued during the validity period and if offer is not accepted by the Vendor, the BID SECURITY shall be forfeited to the Government Accounts.

6. **SHELF LIFE REQUIRED:**

No supply will be accepted having expiry date less than 90% of shelf life for the National manufacturer and 90% for imported items (wherever applicable). The drugs / medicines should have shelf life of 90% for national manufacturer and 70% for imported items.

7. **UNDERTAKING on Rs.100/- Non Judicial Stamp Paper**

7.1 I/we read / understand the conditions specified in the tender inquiry and undertake:

7.2 That I/we will remain bound to supply any item as an additional quantity at the same rate on which said item I/we have supplied during the contract period.

7.3 That I/we agree whether our tender accepted for total, partial or enhanced quantity for all or any single item.

7.4 I/we also agreed to supply and accept the said item at the rates for the supply of contracted quantity within the stipulated period shown in the contract.

7.5 I/we understand and ensure for the supply of quality medicines. I/we also agree to supply the 100% additional quantity without any additional charges, if the supplies/part of the supplies declared sub-standard.

7.6 I/we undertake that, if any of the information submitted in accordance to this tender inquiry found incorrect, our contract may be cancelled at any stage on our cost and risk.

7.7 I/we undertake to deposit the Drug Testing fees per batch to the Provincial / Central Drugs Testing Laboratories, the said fees will be deposited directly to PDL / CDL, if the assignment given to the said laboratories.

7.8 I/we undertake that, I/we will replace the drugs three month before its expiry.

7.9 I/we undertake that, I/we have never been black listed.
