Non-bailable arrest warrants for actress issued

LAHORE: Judicial Magistrate of District Court Ahsan Raza on Friday issued non-bailable arrest warrants for actress Khushbakht alias Sofia Mirza allegedly involved in a fraud case. The court has directed police to arrest the actress and produce her before the court.

The complainant, Shaikh Nasir, got registered a case at the Samanabad Police Station against Sofia Mirza, her brother Khurram Shehzad and others under sections 468/471, 419/420 of PPC. He contended in the FIR that Sofia in connivance with her brother sold him a car LZN 5706. After purchasing the car, he sold it to another person. After that Sofia got registered a car theft case against him. When the car was confiscated by police officials, the car was being used by Sofia Mirza.

417 illegal
clinics, labs
sealed in Punjab

LAHORE: Inspector General of Police, Punjab, Capt (R) Arif Nawaz Khan has said that 8,787 complaint centre received 58,000 applications for lodging FIRs out of which 25 percent were found on fake grounds and other 25 percent based on partial lies.

He was addressing police Darbar at Bahawalpur police lines on Friday. He regretted that police force could not get due respect among common people despite the fact that 1,400 personnel of Punjab police had laid down their lives in the war against terror. "It is a big question why police force is not winning hearts of people while it is fighting against terrorists and providing security to common people," he said.

He said that people told him that they had to face harsh attitude of SHOs, Moharrars and other police officials whenever.

they visited a police station to lodge their complaint. "It is an impression among the masses that police personnel behaved in rude manner with people," he said.

He said, "It was observed that 50 percent part of our society told lie. Registration of FIR on false and baseless statement damages pure and merit based investigation." He urged the masses to avoid lodging false and baseless FIRs against others.

IGP Khan said that criminal elements were only one per cent and added that remaining 99 percent part of society comprised positive and non-criminal people. "When police with respect and behave politely with the people visiting police stations to lodge their complaints, the people would love and respect police force," he said.

He said that police personnel would be equipped with

bulletproof jackets and required modern weapons when they were sent on raid or patrolling or to combat anti-peace elements. "Action will be taken against those in charges of whom negligence would cause loss of life to police personnel.

He emphasised the need to boost professional capability of police force and living standards at police lines and police stations. There shall be filtered water at police stations and standard meal at police lines, he said. He said that cut was made in risk allowance of police force but when he assumed the charge of office of IGP, Punjab, he took up the issue with the chief minister. "I am thankful to the chief minister that on my request, he restored risk allowance of police force," he said. Police personnel would receive risk allowance along with arrears in the salary on October 1st, he added.

LAHORE: Punjab Healthcare Commission (PHC) closed down 417 illegal businesses of quacks in the month of August and initiated legal proceedings against them.

A PHC spokesperson said that the queues were unawfully long, running clinics and laboratories were closed and were unequal to render any kind of medical services by any stretch of the law. The actions have been taken against queues across the Punjab. As a result, 96 businesses were sealed in Bahawalpur, 95 in Lahore, 47 in Faisalabad, 30 in Hafizabad, 21 in Rahimyar Khan, 20 in Faisalabad, 17 in Multan, 10 in Sargodha, 11 in Sialkot, 10 in Nankana Sahib, eight in Rawalpindi, and seven each in Jhelum, Chiniot, whereas multiple clinics were also sealed in Gujranwala, Sahiwal, Gujrat, Pakpattan, Khanewal and Dera Ghazi Khan.

LAHORE: The Lahore High Court has ordered probe into alleged irregularities in the PhD entrance test at Punjab University Institute of Communication Studies and ordered Dean Faculty of Behavioural and Social Sciences to submit report within 15 days.


Justice Shahid Jameel Khan was hearing a petition filed by Khurram Shahzad, a candidate for PhD admission at ICS. The petitioner through his counsel Syed Shahbaz Bukhari advocate submitted that the candidate was a brilliant student and secured first position in his MPH while obtaining 4 out of 4 CGPA.

He submitted that the petitioner was quite confident that he would qualify the entrance test since he had attempted the test in a good manner. However, he submitted, he was victimised on political basis during evaluation of his test and was declared fail.

He submitted that the petitioner had brought to the notice of vice-chancellor, dean and others that answer key of five objective type questions were wrong on which papers of all the candidates had been evaluated while there were confusions in a few other questions which led to attempting wrong answers. Mr. Bhukhari submitted that the petitioner had attempted a few

He submitted that the petitioner had presented references from books and theodolites to support his claim before vice-chancellor and Departmental Doctoral Programme Committee.

He argued that the petitioner had reliably learnt that a failing candidate had been awarded with illegal additional marks and the failed candidate had become topper of the entrance test. He submitted that results of the candidates had been tampered by awarding additional marks to a few blue-eyed candidates to pass them.
