- 2. Language: As determined by **Sukkur Blood Hospital-SBDDS**, the working language of this tender is English.
- 3. Qualifying and Conditions: The main criteria for admission to the tender are as follows:

 - b) Good track-record and references from previous clients
 - c) Recognized bank account (Sukkur Blood Hospital-SBDDS will make all payments through cross cheque or through bank transfers) Proof of the above must be provided if requested.

- 3. Tenders will be opened on the i.e. December 28, 2017 at 01.30 p.m in the presence of suppliers or their representatives, who wish to witness the tender opening.
- 4. A pay order / demand draft in favor of "Sukkur Blood Hospital-SBDDS" with a value of 2% of the bid amount must also accompany the bid as Tender Guarantee. Bids received without pay order / demand draft shall be rejected.
- The delivery address will be Sukkur Blood Hospital field area at Opp: Eidgha Sukkur
- 6. Tender committee reserves the right to cancel/reject any or all offers without assigning any reason.
- 7. Payment will be made on satisfactory delivery of supplies through cross cheque.
- 8. Tender Committee or its representative reserves the right to inspect the goods in successful bidder's warehouse for verification.
- Tender price must be inclusive of delivery costs and all admissible taxes while relevant taxes will be deducted at source. Copies of NTN and GST must also accompany the tenders.

Unless the context indicates otherwise, the term "Buyer" refers to Sukkur Blood Hospital. The term "Supplier" refers to the entity named on the order and contracting with the Buyer. The term "Contract" can be taken to mean either (a) the purchase order or (b) the supply agreement, whichever is in place.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Price: The prices stated on the order shall be held firm for the period and / or quantity unless specifically stated otherwise.
- 2) Source of Instructions: The Supplier shall not seek nor accept instructions from any source external to Sukkur Blood Hospital-SBDDS relation to the performance of the contract.
- 3) Assignment: The Supplier shall not assign, transfer, sublet or subcontract the contract or any part thereof without prior written consent of the Buyer.

- 4) Corruption: The Supplier shall not give, nor offer to give, anyone employed by the Buyer an inducement or gift that could be perceived by others to be a bribe. The Supplier agrees that a breach of this provision may lead to an immediate end to business relationships and termination of existing contracts.
- 5) Confidentiality: All data, including but not limited to, maps, drawings, photographs, estimates, plans, reports and budgets that has been compiled by or received by the Supplier under the contract shall be the property of Sukkur Blood Hospital and shall be treated as confidential. All such data should be delivered to the authorized officials representing the Buyer upon request.
 - 5.1 The Supplier may not communicate at any time to any other person, government or authority external to Sukkur Blood Hospital, any information that has been complied through association with Sukkur Blood Hospital-SBDDS which has not been made public except with written authorization from the Buyer. These obligations do lapse upon termination of the contract.
- 6) Use of Emblem or Name: Unless otherwise agreed in writing; the supplier shall not advertise nor make public the fact that it is not supplying goods or services to the Buyer, nor shall the Supplier in any way whatsoever use the name or emblem of Sukkur Blood Hospital in connection with its business or otherwise.
- 7) Observance of Law: The Supplier shall comply with all laws; ordinances, rules and regulations bearing upon the performance of its obligations under the terms of the contract.
- 8) Force Majeure: The meaning of the term can be taken to mean acts of God, war (declared or not), invasion, revolution, insurrection or acts similar in nature or force.
 - 8.1 In the event of and as soon as possible after the occurrence of any cause deemed force majeure, the Supplier must inform the Buyer of the full particulars in writing. If the Supplier is rendered unable either in part or in whole to perform its obligations then the Buyer shall take such action as it considers, in its sole discretion, to be appropriate or necessary in the circumstances.
 - 8.2 If the Supplier is permanently rendered incapable in whole or part by reason of force majeure to complete its obligations and responsibilities under the contract then the Buyer will have the right to suspend or terminate the contract on the same terms and conditions laid out in section 9, Cancellation.
- 9) Cancellation: The Buyer reserves the right to cancel the contract should it suspend its activities or through changes to its mandate by virtue of the Executive council of Sukkur Blood Hospital and/or lack of funding. In such a case the Supplier shall be reimbursed by Sukkur Blood Hospital for all reasonable costs incurred by the Supplier, including all materials satisfactory delivered and conforming to specification and terms of contract, prior to receipt of the termination notice.
 - 9.1 Should the supplier encounter solvency problems including, but not limited to, bankruptcy, liquidation, receivership and similar, the buyer reserves the right to terminate the contract immediately without prejudice to any other right or remedy it may have under the terms of these conditions.
- 10) Warranty: The Supplier shall provide the Buyer with all manufacturers' warranties. The supplier warrants that all goods supplied in relation to the contract meets specification, is defect free and is fit for the purpose of the intended use. If, during the warranty period, the goods are found to be

defective or non- conforming to specification, the Supplier will either replace the item at their cost or reimburse the Buyer.

- 11) Loss and Indemnity: The Supplier shall compensate the Buyer in full on demand for all loss, damage or injury to the Buyer which results from the Suppliers failure to comply with the Contract (whether negligent or otherwise).
- 12) Insurance: The Supplier shall be at all times fully insured with a reputable insurer against all insurable liability under the Contract.
- 13) Inspection and Test: The Supplier must inspect the goods prior to dispatch to ensure conformance to specification and/or any other provisions of the contract. The Buyer reserves the right to inspect the goods for compliance with specifications and provisions of the contract, If, in the Buyer' opinion, the goods and/or services do not comply with the specification, the Buyer will inform the Supplier in writing. In such a case the Supplier shall take the necessary action to ensure compliance, liability for any additional cost incurred for rectifying compliance will rest with the Supplier.
- 14) Changes: The Buyer reserves the right to make reasonable changes at any time to the specification, drawings, plans, quantity, packing instructions, destination, or delivery instruction. If any such change affects the price of goods or performance of service the Supplier and Buyer may negotiate an equitable adjustment to the contract, provided that the Supplier claims for adjustments in writing to the Buyer within 3 days from being notified of any change.
- 15) Export License: If an export license or licenses are required for the goods, the Supplier has the responsibility to obtain that license or licenses.
- 16) Payment Terms: Unless otherwise agreed, payment terms will be 10 working days from the receipt of goods and invoice.
- 17) Ethics: The nature of SBDDS operations necessitates that the Supplier must maintain ethical and moral standards including but not limited to, no discrimination on the basis of race, gender, religion or age, avoidance of materials/services provided with the use of slavery including child labor. Failure to maintain such standards, in the opinion of the buyer, may result in termination of the Business relationship between the Buyer and Supplier.
- 18) Rights of SBDDS: Should the Supplier fail to perform under the terms and conditions of the contract, including but not limited to failing to obtain export licenses or to make delivery of all or part of the goods by the agreed delivery date(s), the Buyer may, after giving reasonable notice to the Supplier, exercise one or more of the following rights:

 Procure all or part of the goods from an alternate source, in which event the Buyer may hold the

Supplier liable for additional costs incurred.

Refuse to accept all or part of the goods.

Terminate the contract.

- 19) No Agency: This order does not create a partnership between the Buyer and Supplier or make one party the agent for the other for any purpose.
- 20) Severability: If any provision in this Agreement is deemed to be, or becomes invalid, illegal, void or unenforceable under applicable law, such provision will be deemed amended to conform to applicable law so as to become valid and enforceable, or if it cannot be so amended without materially altering the intention of the parties, it will be deleted, but the validity, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions of the Agreement shall not be impaired or affected in any way.

21) Jurisdiction Clause: The Contract shall be governed by Pakistani law and the Supplier consents to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Pakistani courts in all matters regarding it except to the extent that the Buyer invokes the jurisdiction of the courts of any other country.

22) Waivers & Variations:

22.1 A failure to exercise or delay in exercising a right or remedy provided by the Contract or by law does not constitute a waiver of the right or remedy or a waiver of other rights r remedies. No single or partial exercise of a right or remedy provided by the Contract or by law prevents further exercise of the right or remedy or the exercise of another right or remedy.

22.2 No variation of the Contract shall be effective unless it is made in writing and signed by each of the parties.

23) Service of Notices:

23.1 Any notice given under the Contract shall be in writing and may be served:

Personally;

By registered or recorded delivery mail;

By facsimile transmission (confirmed by post);

By any other means which any party specifies by notice to the others.

23.2 Each party's address for the services of notice shall be at their registered address or such other address as specified by notice to the others.

23.3 A notice shall be deemed to have been served:

If it was served in person, at the time of service:

If it was served by post, 48 hours after it was posted: and

If it was served by facsimile transmission, at the time of transmission
