Besides it will also depict mineral identification, mineral resources surrounding natural resources, mining extent, environmental sensitive areas, mineral zoning, mineral formation, change in land (existing land use & land cover) and topography.

- 1. Introduction: The basic aim of this process is to short list of competent consulting firms prior to issue of request of proposal (RFP) for submission of technical and financial proposals. This is to ensure that only firms with appropriate experience, a proven track record, and necessary turnover, which are free of any major pending litigation and that, can provide all required deliverables in a timely manner and will be only invited to submit their proposals.
- EOI Documents: is issued to all interested firms to obtain required information and data in the similar manner, to facilitate the evaluation as per criteria mentioned in it. It comprises of following sections:

a) Section I. Instructions to Consultant(s):

Clause 1 The Bidder shall enclose the (one original and two copies) of the application in a sealed envelope which shall:-

- a) bear the name and address of the Applicant;
- be delivered by hand, or through registered mail to address mentioned in advertisement for EOI or in document; and
- c) be clearly marked "Application for short listing" for "Environmental Mapping for the conservation of mines and natural resources"

Clause 2 if the envelope is not sealed and marked as required, the procuring agency will assume no responsibility for the misplacement of the application.

Clause 3 The applications shall be prepared in the English language. Information in any other language shall be accomplished by its translation in English.

Clause 4 The Applicants must respond to all questions and provide complete informations as advised in this document. Any lapses to provide essential information may result rejection of the Application.

Clause 5 Clarification and Modification of EOI Documents (SPPRA Rule 23). Any Applicant, who has obtained EIO documents, may request for clarification of contents of the document in writing, and respond to such queries shall be made in writing within three calendar days, provided they are received at least five calendar days prior to the date of opening of bid.

Clause 6 Addendum: At any time prior to the deadline for submission of application, the agency may amend the EIO Document by issuing addenda. Any addendum issued shall be part of the EIO Document and shall be communicated in writing to all who have obtained the document.

Clause 7 Deadline for submission of Applications (SPPRA Rule 22 & 24): Applications shall be received by, Mines & Mineral Development Department, not later than the 16.02.2018 at 05.00 p.m. The procuring agency may, at its discretion, extend for the submission of Applications by amending the EOI Document, and in which case all rights and obligations of the Agency and the Applicants subject to the previous deadline shall thereafter by subject to the deadline as extended.

Clause 8 Evaluation (Rule 74): The Applicant's general and particular experience, personnel, and financial position, as demonstrated by the Applicant's responses in the prescribed form(s) will be evaluated as per evaluation criteria given in the document. The procuring Agency reserves the right to waive minor deviations, if these don't materially affect the capability of an applicant to perform the contract.

Clause 9 Clarification of Applications (Rule 43): To assist in the evaluation of Applications, the agency may, at its discretion, ask any Applicant for a clarification of its application which shall be submitted within a stated reasonable period of time. Any request for clarification and all clarifications hall be in writing. If an applicant does not provide clarifications of the information requested by the date and time set in the agency's requested for clarification, its Application may be rejected.

Clause 10 Verification of Prequalification (Rule 28 (Id): Verification of the information provided by the applicants in the submission for short listing may be made. In case the information is found to be wrong or incorrect in any material way or the applicant is found to be lacking in the capability or resources to successfully perform the contract, the application shall not be entertained.

- Collection of base line data for natural resources environmental features, physical & topographic features of the mining area, mineral resources location of the Mines, condition of the Mines, extent of operation, change in land (existing land use and land cover) habitations, residences, population & Socio economic condition, geo referenced based information.
- Development of Digital Environmental maps of Mining area which involves.
 - Procurement of high resolution Satellite images i.e 1:5,000.
 - Image geo referencing.
 - Ground truthing.
 - Overlaying of existing & new maps that includes digitalization of satellite imaginary and overlaying of existing maps.
 - Ground verification survey.
 - Base map Development & preparation of base map.
