Leading activists Syrian rout

• Protests in Homs after Deraa falls to

AMMAN: Security forces on Monday rounded up hundreds of pro-democracy sympathisers, including prominent human rights campaigner Diana Jawabra for the second time during Syria's uprising, witnesses said.

The arrests came in the wake of the shelling of Deraa, cradle of the unrest, by a force led by President Bashar al-Assad's feared brother Maher.

"I am Dana Jawabra from Deraa," Jawabra shouted as she was forced into a white Kia secret police car outside her home in the Mezza West District of Damascus.

The 39-year-old engineer was arrested on March 16 while taking part in a silent protest in Damascus to demand the release of thousands of political prisoners in Syria.

Among them were 15 schoolchildren who had been detained in Deraa for writing freedom slogans on walls, inspired by the Tunisian and Egyptian revolutions.

The arrests of Jawabra and others were a major cause of the

eruption of pro-democracy demonstrations in the south city.

She was released on March 18, but President Bashar al-Assad made vague promises for reforms that failed to stop mass demonstrations from spreading to other parts across Syria.

In the old quarter of Deraa shelled and machinegunned in submission on Saturday, security forces forced their way into homes on Sunday and took away many men under 40, witnesses told Reuters by telephone.

At least 560 civilians have been killed by Assad's security forces since the Deraa uprising erupted on March 18, human rights groups say.

The government, condemned by the West for their repression of unrest, has blamed the violence on "armed terrorist groups." The country of 20 million people has been under authoritarian Baath Party rule since 1963.

Security police dispersed an all-women protest at Al-Sayidat square in Damascus on Monday. Another all-women demon-

Yemen protesters to raise Osama

SANAA: Yemeni activists urged street protesters on Monday not to raise banners of Osama bin Laden to avoid triggering a harsher crackdown on demonstrations seeking democratic change in the al Qaeda leader's ancestral homeland.

Bin Laden was killed in a fire-fight with US forces in Pakistan on Monday, ending a nearly 10-year worldwide manhunt for the leader of the global Islamist militant network that orchestrated the Sept. 11 attacks on the United States.

Tens of thousands of Yemeni protesters have camped out for three months in public squares across the impoverished Arabian Peninsula state to demand the

departure of President Abdullah Saleh, who has autocratically for nearly 33 years and has long been a US ally in the fight against al Qaeda.

"We expect Saleh's resignation to use al Qaeda as an excuse to confront the protests during his departure, but we will expose attempts like this," Meshaal Mujahid, an al Qaeda spokesman, said. Another protester said he was concerned that the death of bin Laden would detract from the mission of the protesters.

"We are not working for al Qaeda and Osama bin Laden. We have one cause and that is the fall of the regime. This matters to us," said Mohammed Saad, a protester in San

COLOMBO: Hundreds of Maldivians took the streets on Monday demanding reforms, after violent weekend demonstrations injured scores and led to the arrest of 52 people, police said.

Protesters, led by former President Maumoon Abdul Gayoom's Dhivehi Raaiyithunge Party, had gathered in the crowded capital of Male for the third day, demanding the government ease food prices and curb rising unemployment.

Eyewitnesses said riot police were patrolling the streets, as around 2,000 demonstrators, mostly young people, made their way to Male's Youth

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
