Benazir Bhutto Shaheed Youth Development Program* (BBSYDP), is a mega initiative of the Government of Sindh striving for the alleviation of poverty and unemployment through Human Resource Development [Short Term Trainings in Employable Trades for youth]. After the successful completion of Phase-I & II, the Program is now successfully completing its 3rd Phase.

Program acknowledges the recognition for awarding grant by Government of Japan, under JSDF [Japan Social Development Fund], through World Bank, who has sponsored a grant for the Skill Development of 5,050 Youth through the Program. Under this grant, the Program is going to initiate training programs through PSTW, for the youth falling in the specific categories of laid off workers, Poor & Vulnerable Youth (Youth from BISP households, 5 Poorest Districts and from flood affected districts) and all returning migrants.

Provincial Coordination Unit invites Expression of Interest (EOI) from Organizations/ Institutes / Consortiums / Companies / Associations / NGOs / Industrial Establishments imparting recognized short term [2-6 months] "Skill Based trainings followed by facilitation for employment", preferably in the following employable sectors/trades or the sectors/trades which are proven by them as employable to participate in the program through well prepared EOI / Proposals, based on "Key Performance Indicators" for providing skill based trainings. Public Sector Institutes including Technical & Vocational Training institutes functioning in Sindh may participate through proper channel through their Administrative Departments; however, terms & conditions for the procurement will remain same for both i.e. Public & Private Training Partners [Detail is available in the Prequalification Document]

[The training shall be based on an updated International Standard Classification of Occupations (ISCO) by International Labour Organization (ILO) and the proposer[s] professional presence in interior Sindh at district headquarters level will be preferred].

- Agro & Horticulture [Backyard farming, Floriculture etc.]
- Early Childhood Education [Montessori Teaching-Females only]
- Heavy Machinery [Operators, Mechanics]
- IT & related [CCNA, Multimedia Graphics, Dot net, Oracle, PHP, Oracle etc.]
- Textile [Garments, Tailoring, Stitching, Fashion Designing, Embroidery etc.]
- Transport [Drivers, Mechanics, Atuo-Electrician etc.]
- Media [Electronic & Print etc.]
- Trades Related with Women Empowerment [Beautician, Fashion designing, Homemade products etc.]
- Any other Employable Sector/Trade with proven market and sustainable employability including entrepreneurship.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

The following information supported with the documents required for the pre-qualification:
Relevant training experience and past performance.

- Registration with Recognized Certificate / Diploma awarding Board / University -[National or International- An international certification SHALL be preferred in related sectors / trades]
- Capabilities of training in respect of infrastructure, faculty, equipment/machines and other resources.
- Capabilities of facilitation for providing post training employment

- All those interested may obtain & submit "Expression of Interest for Initial Screening of Service Provider" from/to the A&F Section, PCU-BBSYDP, on submission of a pay order amounting to Rs. 1000/- (non-refundable) in the name of Provincial Coordinator, BBSYDP, Karachi; along with "Letter of Interest (LOI)", by or before 12:00noon on 27th June, 2011 (In case of falling a public holiday, the next working day will be treated as closing date)
- Duly completed document as mentioned above be received before the closing time & date will be opened on the same date at 2:00pm in the presence of all the interested applicants who wish to be present.
