



**SECTION II
INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS**

1. Scope of Bid:

- 1.1 The Livestock Department Government of Sindh invites bids for the supply of veterinary medicines, vaccines, veterinary hospital tools / Instruments and animal feed specified in the schedule of requirements along with technical Specifications.

2. Source of Funds

- 2.1 The Government of Sindh allocated funds in the specific Head of Accounts of the purpose of the purchase of drugs/medicines/equipment/instruments/vaccines/animal feed etc. under Development & Non-Development budgetary provisions, for office of the Director Animal Husbandry and field offices of Animal Husbandry in Sindh.

3. Eligible Bidders:

- 3.1 The invitation for bids is open to all original manufactures / their authorized sole agents/ suppliers and in case of imported goods their authorized dealers / importers / suppliers for supply of goods more specifically described in the schedule of requirement.

4. Corrupt or Fraudulent Practices and Mechanism to Debar/Blacklist the Defaulted Bidder.

- 4.1 The Government of Sindh defines Corrupt and Fraudulent Practices as "corrupt practice is the offering, giving, receiving or soliciting, directly or indirectly, of anything of value to influence the action of a public official or the contractor in the procurement process or in contract execution to the detriment of the procuring agency; or misrepresentation of the facts in order to influence a procurement process or the execution of a contract, collusive practices among bidders (prior to or after bid submission) designed to establish bid prices at artificial, non-competitive levels and to deprive the procuring agency of the benefits of free and open competition and any request for, or solicitation of anything of value by any public official in the course of the exercise of his duty; it may include any of the following practices:
- (i) Coercive practice by impairing or harming, or threatening to impair or harm, directly or indirectly, any party or the property of the party to influence improperly the actions of a party to achieve a wrongful gain or to cause a wrongful loss to another party;
 - (ii) Collusive practice by arrangement between two or more parties to the procurement process or contract execution, designed to achieve with or without the knowledge of the procuring agency to establish prices at artificial, non-competitive levels for any wrongful gain.

- (iii) Corrupt practice by offering, giving, receiving or soliciting, directly or indirectly, of anything of value to influence the act of another party for wrongful gain;
 - (iv) Fraudulent practice by any act or omission, including a misrepresentation, that knowingly or recklessly misleads, or attempts to mislead, a party to obtain a financial or other benefit or to avoid an obligation;
 - (v) Obstructive practice by harming or threatening to harm directly or indirectly, persons or their property to influence their participation in a procurement process, or affect the execution of a contract or deliberately destroying, falsifying, altering or concealing of evidence material to the investigation or making false statements to investigators in order to materially impede an investigation into allegations of a corrupt, fraudulent, coercive or collusive practice; or threatening, harassing or intimidating any party to prevent it from disclosing its knowledge of matters relevant to the investigation or from pursuing the investigation, or acts intended to materially impede the exercise of inspection and audit rights;
- 4.2 Indulgence in corruption and fraudulent practices is liable to result in rejection of Bids, cancellation of contracts, debarring and blacklisting of the Bidder, for a stated or indefinite period of time.

4.3 The following are the events which would lead to initiate under Rule 35 of SPPRA Rules 2010 Blacklisting / Debarment process.

- i. Submission of false, fabricated / forged documents for procurement in tender.
- ii. Not attaining required quality of work.
- iii. Inordinate tardiness in accomplishment of assigned / agreed responsibilities / contractual obligations resulting loss to procuring agency / Government.
- iv. Non execution of work as per terms and conditions of contract.
- v. Any unethical or unlawful professional or business behavior detrimental to good conduct and integrity of the public procurement process.
- vi. Involvement in any sort of tender fixing.
- vii. Persistent and international violation of important conditions of contract.
- viii. Non-adherence to quality specification despite being importunately pointed out.
- ix. Security consideration of the State i.e., any action that jeopardizes the security of the State or good repute of the procuring agency.

PROCEDURE: A notice will be issued to the agency / individual seeking it /his explanation for the lapses committed by it/him. The explanation will be required within 03 days from the date of issue, (time will be fixed depending upon the intensity of lapses). In case it/his explanation is found unsatisfactory, a show cause notice shall be issued providing an opportunity of being heard following by decision for blacklisting for a maximum period of three years, depending upon the intensity of lapses. The letter for debarring the agency / individual will be published on SPPRA website. Once the blacklisting order is issued, it shall not be revoked ordinarily unless as provided under Rule-35 of the procurement Rules 2010.

5 Eligibility Goods & Services:

- 5.1 All goods and related services to be supplied under the contract shall confirm to the policies of the Government of Sindh in vogue. All expenditure made under the contract shall be limited to such goods and services. For purpose of this clause (a), the term Goods includes any goods, that are the subject of this invitation for bid and (b) the term Services includes related ancillary services such as transportation, insurance, installation, after sale services etc.

6 Cost of Bidding:

- 6.1 The Bidders shall bear all cost associated with the preparation and submission of its bid, and the Procuring agency shall in no case be responsible or liable for those cost, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the Bidding process.
- 6.2 In the case of offer supply of items/ stores from within the country, price quoted shall be inclusive of all taxes (Present and Future) duties and charges for packing, making, handling, transportation / delivery charges etc. up to consignee.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. The Governing Rules:

- 1.1 The Bidding procedure shall be governed by the Sindh Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (SPPRA) 2010 (amended 2017).
- 1.2 Condition as per Tender Notice will remain valid however procuring agency reserves the right to extend date & time of bid. Opening or receiving the bids and to purchase all or part of store under the tender.
- 1.3 Any cutting / correction in bid form will make the quotation invalid.
- 1.4 Procurement Committee reserves the right to obtain clarification from any bidder, in respect of items quoted by him. The replies by the bidder will be recorded and will form part of bid document.
- 1.5 100% payment shall be released on receipt of consignment in full.
- 1.6 The contracting firm will be treated under SPPRA Rules, accordingly in case of failure in supply of stores; it shall be optioned to purchase the stores elsewhere without notice on account and risk the contract.
- 1.7 All the items be supplied within the period indicated in supply order and failure to do so may result in forfeit of earnest money/ performance money as per SPPRA Rules as amended.
- 1.8 Breaking / leakage during transport is the responsibility of supplier.
- 1.9 No medicine / drug will be accepted with the expiry less than 2 year or less than 75% shelf life.
- 1.10 All the rates quoted must be inclusive of all the taxes Imposed by the Government time-to-time.
- 1.11 The rates offered will be valid for the financial year 2017-18.
- 1.12 For non GST items, GST be quoted separately with the offered price for the item. The SAP system at account office may deduct automatically the applicable GST for the taxable quoted item.
- 1.13 The sealed tenders will be opened on same day before interested bidders.
- 1.14 All the firms are required to attach on affidavit of above agreement and that their firms has not declare black listed by Provincial and Federal Government on Stamp Paper worth Rs:100/-
- 1.15 All the items must be stamped Govt. of Sindh Property, Not for Sale & year of Supply.
- 1.16 Supply orders will be issued subject to the availability of funds.

2. Applicable Bidding Procedure:

- 2.1 The Bidding Procedure is governed by SPPRA rule 46 "Procedure of open Competitive Bidding" Sub-rule (2) "Single Stage- One Envelop above to confirm the bidding procedure applicable in the present bidding process.
- 2.2 The Bidding procedure prescribed in the Bid data Sheet above is explained in the below.

3. Single Stages: One Envelope Procedure:

- 3.1 The bid shall comprise a single package containing one envelope. Each envelope shall contain technical and financial proposal.
- 3.2 The procuring agency shall evaluate the technical and financial proposal and reject any proposal which do not confirm to the specified requirements.
- 3.3 During the technical evaluation no amendments in the technical proposal shall be permitted.
- 3.4 The bid found to be the lowest evaluated bid shall be accepted.

4. The Bidding Document (Contents of the Bidding Documents)

- 4.1 The goods required, applicable bidding procedures, and Contract terms are prescribed in the Bidding Document. In addition to the Invitation for Bids, the Bidding Documents include:
 - (a) Instruction to Bidders (ITB) (Section-II).
 - (b) Evaluation Criteria (Section-III).
 - (c) Bid Forms (Section-IV).
 - i) Letter of Intention
 - ii) Affidavit
 - iii) Technical/Financial information
- 4.2 The "Invitation of Bids" is not a formal part of the Bidding Documents and is included as a reference only. In case of discrepancies between the Invitation for Bids and the Bidding Documents listed in 10.1 above, the Bidding Documents shall take precedence.
 - 4.1.1 The Bidder is expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms and specifications in the Bidding Documents. Failure to furnish all information required by the Bidding Documents or to submit a bid not substantially responsive to the Bidding Documents in every respect shall be at the Bidder's risk and may result in the rejection of its bid.

5 Clarification(s) on Bidding Documents

5.1A prospective Bidder requiring any clarification(s) on the bidding Documents may notify the Procuring Agency¹ in writing at the Procuring Agency's address indicated in the Bid Data Sheet. The Procuring Agency shall respond in writing to any request for clarification(s) of the bidding documents, which it receives no later than seven (7) days prior to the deadline for the submission of bids prescribed in the Invitation for bids. Written copies of the Procuring Agency's response (including an explanation of the query but without identifying source of enquiry) shall be sent to all prospective bidders that have received the Bidding Documents.

6 Amendment(s) to the Bidding Documents

- 6.1 At any time prior to the deadline for submission of applications, the Procuring Agency, for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification(s) requested by a prospective bidder, may amend the Tender Document by issuing addenda.
- 6.2 Any addendum issued shall be part of the Tender Document and shall be communicated in writing either through post, email or Fax, to all who have obtained the Tender document from the Procuring Agency.
- 6.3 In order to give prospective Bidders reasonable time to take an addendum into account in preparing their applications, the Procuring Agency may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of bids.

7. Language of Bids

- 7.1 All correspondences, communications, associated with preparation of bids, clarifications, amendments, and submission shall be written in English. Supporting documents and printed literature furnished by the bidder may be in another language provided they are accompanied by the accurate translation in English or Urdu, in which case, for purpose of interpretation of the bid, the said translation shall take precedence.

8. Documents comprising the Bids.

- 8.1 The Bid shall comprise of the Bid Forms of this bidding Document and all those ancillary documentations that are prescribed for the eligibility of the Bidders and goods and ancillary services that are found necessary and highlighted in the Bid Forms in Section-IV.

9. Bid Price:

- 9.1 The bidder shall indicate on the appropriate form prescribed in the bidding document the unit price and total bid price of the goods, it proposes to supply on free delivery to the consignee end under the contract.
- 9.2 Form prescribed for quoting of prices is to be filled in very carefully, preferably typed. Any alteration/ correction must be initialed. Every page is to be signed and stamped at the bottom. Serial number of the quoted item may be marked with red/ yellow marker.
- 9.3 The bidder should quote the prices of goods according to the technical specification as provided in the bidding document. The technical specification of goods, different from the required specification shall straightway be rejected.
- 9.4 The bidders are required to offer a competitive price. All prices must include the taxes and duties, where applicable. If there is no inclusive of taxes, the offered/ quoted price shall be considered as inclusive of all prevailing taxes/ duties.
- 9.5 While making a price quote, trend/ inflation in the rate of goods and services in the market should be kept in mind. No request for increase in the price due to market fluctuation in the cost of goods and services shall be entertained.

10. Bid Currencies:

- 10.1 Price shall be quoted in Pak Rupees.

11. Samples & Supporting Documents to judge specifications:

- 11.1 The Bidders shall provide the leaflet / brochures / catalogs of quoted Products with the bid at his own cost.
- 11.2 The Bidder shall provide samples of quoted goods along with the bid at his own cost and in a quantity, and same will be sent for the examination of Quality Control to the Government National Veterinary Laboratory (NVL) Islamabad on bidder's expenses what so ever.

12. Documentation on Eligibility of Bidders:

- 12.1 Bidders shall furnish documents establishing the bidder's eligibility to the bid and its qualification to perform the contract its bid is accepted.
- 12.2 The documentary evidence of the bidder's eligibility to bid shall establish to the procuring agency's satisfaction that the bidder, at the time of submission of its bid, is an eligible.

13. Bid Security:

- 13.1 The bidder shall furnish, as part of its bid, a bid security in the amount specified in the bid data sheet. Unsuccessful bidders bid security shall be discharged or returned soon after announcement of the successful bids.
- 13.2 The successful bidder's security shall be discharged upon signing of contract/purchase order and furnishing the performance security upto 10% of the contract award and show liquid assets equal to 50% minimum of contract award.
- 13.3 If a bidder withdraw its bid during the period of bid validity.
- 13.4 In case of a successful bidder, if bidder fails to sign the contract / purchased order and fails to provide the performance security (if any).

14. Late Bids:

- 14.1 Any bid received by the procuring agency after the deadlines for submission shall be rejected and returned unopened to the bidder. The Procuring Agency may at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of applications.

15. Bid Validity:

- 15.1 Bids shall remain valid for the period identified in the bid data sheet after the date of opening of bid. A bid valid for a shorter period shall be rejected by the procuring agency and will be dealt as per SPPRA rules.
- 15.2 The Procuring Agency shall ordinarily be under an obligation to process and evaluate the bid within the stipulated bid validity period. However, under exceptional circumstances and for reason to be recorded in writing, if an extension is considered necessary, all those who have submitted their bids shall be asked to extend their respective bid validity period. Such extension shall be for not more than the period equal to the period of original bid validity.
- 15.3 Bidders who:
 - (a) Agree to the Procuring Agency's request for extension of bid validity period shall not be permitted to change the substance of their bids; and
 - (b) Do not agree to an extension of the bid validity period shall be allowed to withdraw their bids without forfeiture of their bid securities.

16. Submission of Bids

Sealing and Marking of Bids

- 16.1 The envelopes shall be marked as **"TENDER DOCUMENT"** in bold and legible letters to avoid confusion. Similarly, the Bidder shall seal the proposal/bids.
- (a) The envelopes shall be addressed to the Procuring Agency at the address given in the invitation for Bids; and Bid Reference No. indicated in the Bid Data Sheet and a statement: **"DO NOT OPEN BEFORE"** the time and the date specified in the Bid Data Sheet for opening of Bids.
- 16.2 The envelopes shall also indicate the name and address of the Bidder to enable the bid to be returned unopened in case it is declared as "non-responsive" or "late".
- 16.3 If the outer envelope is not sealed and marked as mentioned above, the Procuring Agency shall assume no responsibility for the bid's misplacement or premature opening.

17 Withdrawal of Bids

- 17.1 The Bidder may withdraw its bid after the bid's submission and prior to the deadline prescribed for submission of bids.
- 17.2 No bid may be withdrawn in the period between deadline for submission of bids and the expiration of the period of bid validity specified in Bid Data Sheet. Withdrawal of a bid during this period may result in forfeiture of the Bid Security submitted by the Bidder, pursuant to the ITB Clause 20 above.

18. Opening and evaluation of Bids:

- 18.1 All bids received shall be opened by the procuring agency publicly in the presence of the bidders or their representatives on the date, time and venue prescribed in the bid data sheet.
- 18.2 The opening of bids shall be subject to the bidding procedure prescribed in the bid data sheet and elaborated in clause 02 above.
- 18.3 All bidders in attendance shall sign an attendance sheet.
- 18.4 The procuring agency shall open one bid at a time and read out aloud its contents which may include name of bidders, bided for and unit prices and total amount of the bid (if applicable) which is deemed appropriate if not in conflict with the SPPRA rules 2010 (Amended 2017).
- 18.5 No bid shall be rejected at technical proposal / bid opening, except for late bids which shall be returned unopened to the bidder.

19. Evaluation of Bids.

- 19.1 The Procuring Agency shall evaluate and compare the bids, which have been determined to be substantially responsive in accordance with the ITB

- 19.2 All bids shall be evaluated in accordance with Evaluation Criteria and other terms and conditions set forth in these bidding documents.
- 19.3 A bid once opened in accordance with the prescribed procedure shall be subject to only those rules, regulations and policies that are in force at the time of issue of notice for invitation of bids.

20 Qualification of Bidder

- 20.1 The Procuring Agency, at any stage of the procurement proceedings, having credible reasons for or prima facie evidence of any defect in Bidder's capacities, may require the Bidder to provide information concerning their professional, technical, financial, legal, or managerial competence.
- 20.2 Such qualification shall only be laid down after recording reasons thereof in writing. They shall form part of the records of that procurement proceeding.
- 20.3 The Procuring Agency shall determine to its satisfaction whether a Bidder, technically and financially qualified and even having the lowest evaluated responsive bid is qualified to perform the Contract satisfactorily.
- 20.4 The determination can take into account the Bidder's financial, technical and production capabilities. It shall be based upon an examination of the documentary evidence of the Bidder's qualifications submitted by the Bidder, as well as such other information as the Procuring Agency deems necessary and appropriate. Further, during the process of technical evaluation of Bidder, the Procuring Agency may inspect the manufacturing plant/production capacity/ warehousing system/ practices by a team of experts for assessment, if it deems necessary.
- 20.5 An affirmative determination shall be a prerequisite for award of the Contract to the Bidder. A negative determination shall result in rejection of the Bidder's bid, in which event the Procuring Agency shall proceed to the next lowest evaluated bid to make a similar determination of the Bidder's capabilities to perform satisfactorily.
- 20.6 The Procuring Agency shall disqualify a Bidder if it finds, at any time, that the materially inaccurate or incomplete.

21 Cancellation of Bids

- 21.1 The Procuring Agency may cancel any or all bids at any time prior to the acceptance of a bid in accordance with Rule 25(1) of Sindh Public Procurement Act (SPPRA) 2010. The Procuring Agency shall upon request communicate to any Bidder who submitted a bid, the grounds for its rejection of any or all bids, but is not required to justify those grounds.
- 21.2 The Procuring Agency incurs no liability, solely by virtue of its invoking Clause 21.1 towards Bidders who have submitted bids.
- 21.3 Notice of the rejection of any or all bids shall be given promptly to the concerned Bidders that submitted bids.

22 Re-Bidding.

- 22.1 If the Procuring Agency cancels all bids in pursuant to ITB Clause 21, it may call for a re-bidding. The Procuring Agency, if it deems necessary may prescribe another method of procurement not inconsistent with the SPPRA Rules 2010 (amended in 2017).
- 22.2 The Procuring Agency before invitation for re-bidding shall assess the reasons for rejection and may revise specifications, evaluation criteria or any other condition for Bidders, as it may deem necessary.

23. Announcement of evaluation Report:

- 23.1 The Procuring agency shall announce the results of the bid evaluation report in the form of a report giving reasons for acceptance or rejection of bids. The report shall be hoisted on website of the authority/ SPPRA and that of the procuring agency if its website exist and intimated to all the bidders at least seven days prior to the award of contract.

24. Award of Contract

24.1 Acceptance of Bid and Award Criteria.

The Bidder whose bid is found to be most closely conforming to the Evaluation Criteria prescribed in Section IV and having the lowest evaluated bid if not in conflict with any other law, rules, regulations, or policy of the Sindh Government, shall be awarded the Contract, within the original or extended period of bid validity.

24.2 Procuring Agency's Right to vary quantities at the time of Award.

The Procuring Agency reserves the right at the time of award of Contract to increase or decrease, the quantity of goods originally specified in Section-III i.e., Schedule of Requirements & Technical Specifications without any change in unit price and other terms and conditions. The Procuring Agency may receive quantities of medicine(s) in parts as per convenience during the current financial year.

25. Notification of Award

- 25.1 Prior to the expiration period of the bid validity, the Procuring Agency shall notify to the successful Bidder in writing that its bid has been accepted.
- 25.2 The Livestock Department will notify the Successful Lowest Evaluated Bidders for each item to Award Advance Acceptance of Tenders (AATs), & issuance of Purchase Orders in favor of the successful Bidder strictly in accordance with the rates finalized by the Livestock Department under Terms & Conditions of the advertised Bidding Document & after fulfillment of all prescribed legal and codal formalities.

26. Limitation on Negotiations

- 26.1 The enforcement of the Contract shall be governed by Rule 52 of SPPRA, Rule, 2010.
- 26.2 Save and otherwise provided in SPPRA, Rule, 2010, Procuring Agency shall not negotiate with any bidder.

27. Performance Security:

- 27.1 After signing of contract, the successful bidders shall furnish a performance security within a week, equivalent 10% in the form of pay order / demand draft of the total contract and the validity period of at least six months. Performance security shall be released to the supplier upon successful completion of the contract. Supplier bid security already submitted with the bid shall only be released upon satisfactory submission of a performance security.
- 27.2 The bid security submitted by the bidder at the time of submitting its bid shall be returned to the bidder upon submission of performance security.
- 27.3 Failure to provide a performance security by the bidder is a sufficient ground for annulment of the award and forfeiture of the bid security. In such event the procuring agency may award the contract to the next lowest evaluated bidder or call for new bid.

28. Liquid assets:

- 28.1 At the time of signing of contract, the successful bidders shall show the liquid assets at least equal to 50% of the contract award in shape of prize bond / bank balance.

29. Price Reasonability Certificate:






